



What dates may I apply for?

Our Selection Panels plan programmes for a full year from the coming 1st April to the following 31st March.

I am a first-time exhibitor. Does this matter?

Not at all. We welcome applications from all artists, whether they are seasoned exhibitors or new to the idea. Our goal is to create a fresh and interesting programme of exhibitions for the Forum Space, with as varied mediums and ideas as possible.

I am a sculptor. Can I exhibit?

Unfortunately we only have wall hanging fixtures to offer in our Forum Space. We do not have any cabinets or plinths upon which to showcase free-standing art. However, if you can provide your own plinths, or your art is large and free-standing, please do apply and make this clear in your application.

What is the Half Gallery option?

Opting for a Half Gallery slot allows you to utilise just one wall instead of two, and possibly share the full space with another artist – great if you do not yet have a large body of work, or if your artworks are smaller. Please note that the two walls are different, one curved and one flat.

How many exhibitions are accepted?

This will depend on how the dates fall each year, other Forum events and how many exhibitors apply for the full or half gallery options. We try to plan a varied programme, but also one which is balanced. If you are not successful, it does not necessarily mean we will not be interested in future Panels – simply that we did not feel it was right for this particular season.

Will you promote my exhibition?

We will share the exhibition on our Social Media channels and send out a Press Release. We are unable to promise poster displays. If you accept an offer to exhibit with us, we will send you further information.

May I apply with a friend or group?

Absolutely. Joint applications are welcomed for both Full and Half options.
